

Installation of Rhino and Grasshopper on Windows

Rhino

- Make sure you are connected to tue-wpa2 or via a VPN connection.
- Go to `\\archnas3\software\Rhinoceros\Rhino50` and copy `Rhino5_setup.exe` to your own computer
- Run `Rhino5_setup.exe` and follow the instruction on your screen.
- Select 'Float my license on the network using the Zoo' and tick 'I agree to the terms and conditions'
- (You can, if desired, untick 'Send registration to McNeel')
- Click 'Next', and 'Next' again to start the installation
- Open Rhino, select 'Use the following Zoo Server:' and fill in 'tuelicense2.campus.tue.nl'.
- Test Connectivity, if succesfull click 'OK'
- Open Rhino, 'Check for updates' via the 'Help' menu and install the updates if needed.
- Close Rhino

Grasshopper

- Go to <http://www.grasshopper3d.com/page/download-1> and download Grasshopper for Rhino 5.0.
- Enter your e-mail address, click 'Next' , and 'Download Now'.
- Run the downloaded .rhi file and follow the instructions.
- Open Rhino and accept the Grasshopper License Agreement
- Open grasshopper by entering "Grasshopper" in the command line in Rhino.
